What is mySecurityZone?

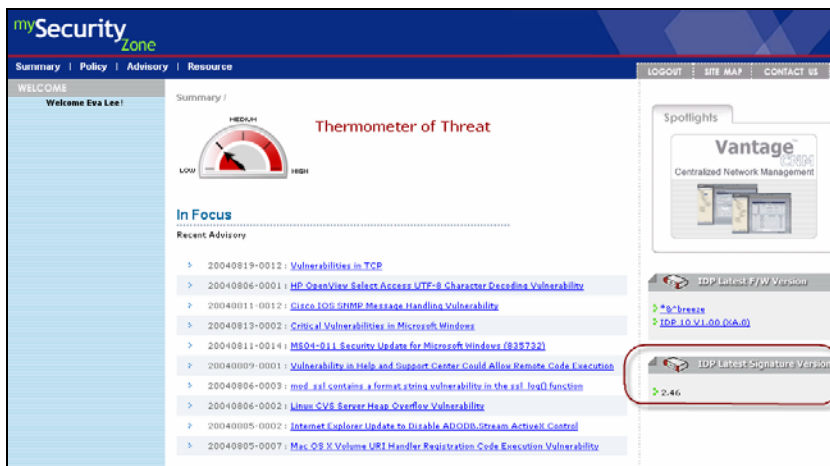
mySecurityZone is a free service for all ZyWALL IDP owners. After you registered your ZyWALL IDP on myZyXEL.com, you can use the same username/password to login to **mySecurityZone** to view detail description for all policies in ZyWALL IDP.

To view description on specific policy, you can enter the policy ID to speed up the search. Policy ID can be found predefined policies in ZyWALL IDP 10 or system logs sent by it.


How do I make sure my ZyWALL IDP10 already has the latest policy?

You can check the latest policy version on **mySecurityZone**



